



THE 2010 KWP-NA Stallion Service Auction

(SSA) – Rules, Process and Agreement

The bid page will be available on the website when the auction opens.

- The Service Auction (SSA) will open January 18th, 2010 and will end at 8:00 p.m. EST on February 17th, 2010.
- The 2010 SSA will be conducted by Internet bidding only. However, the KWP-NA office can function as a proxy and bid for you if special circumstances prohibit a bidder from doing so on-line. Please get this set up with the office ahead of time.
- Members are able to sign up and bid on-line. Bidders must sign up by noon on February 17th, 2010.
- Foals resulting from these breedings must be eligible for KWP registration and are subject to all KWP-NA rules and regulations.
- **Fresh or Frozen Semen with Live Foal Guarantee** - The minimum bid will be **\$600.00**.
 - This bid will cover all booking and initial collection fees for the donated stallion.
 - The winning bidder will be responsible for shipping and container fees in addition to the winning bid.
 - The winning bidder will receive a maximum of 2 shipments. Arrangements after the receipt of 2 shipments must be made with the stallion owner/breeding agent at which time additional booking and collection fees will be assessed to the winning bidder/mare owner.
 - Live Foal Guarantee policies **will be** in affect for donated stallions offering fresh cooled semen per the stallion owner's/breeding agent's contract.
 - Live Foal Guarantee policies **will not be** in affect for donated stallions offering frozen semen per the stallion owner's/breeding agent's contract.
 - Bidders are strongly advised to obtain a copy of the stallion owner's Breeding contract prior to submitting a bid.
- **Frozen Semen without live foal guarantee** - The minimum bid will be **\$450.00**.
 - This bid will cover all booking and handling fees for the donated stallion.
 - The winning bidder will be responsible for shipping and container fees in addition to the winning bid.
 - The winning bidder will receive two (2) insemination doses of frozen semen.
 - Arrangements for storage must be made with the stallion owner/breeding agent.
 - Live Foal Guarantee policies **will not be** in affect for donated stallions offering frozen semen per the stallion owner's/breeding agent's contract.
- There will be no KWP-NA surcharge due on any winning bids.
- **Bids may be raised in increments of \$25.00.**
- The stallion services offered in this auction are intended for the 2010 breeding season (arrangements must be made and approved by stallion owner/breeding agent for the use of the breeding dose beyond the 2010 breeding season.)
- Should the bidder's designated mare be deemed unfit to enter into the breeding service contract, the bidder has the option to substitute an acceptable mare, or forfeit the bid for that stallion service. Breedings are not transferable to another person, except with express permission from the stallion owner/agent.
- The winning bidder's semen will not be shipped until the stallion owner's contract has been signed and until the stallion owner has received notification from the KWP-NA office that financial obligations have been met.

- Bids are binding and cannot be withdrawn. A bidder may bid on any number of stallion services, however, by placing a bid you are making a legal contract between yourself and the KWPN-NA for each service you bid on.
- By clicking on the "bidding page", you will be able to see the current high bid for each stallion and update any bids.
- The winning bidders will be notified via e-mail at the close of the auction.
- Bids will be paid by Visa/MC within 48 hours of the close of the auction. Visa/MC information must be sent to the KWPN-NA office when signing up to become a bidder.
- The highest bidder of the entire 2010 Stallion Service Auction shall receive a free foal registration for the foal in the year 2011.
- The breeder of the highest ranking foal (scoring over 65 points), in any of the five breeding directions of the KWPN-NA that is shown as a weanling at the 2011 keuringen tour and was a result of the 2010 SSA shall receive a winning prize of \$250.00.

There will be no bid withdrawals, exceptions or refunds given. In other words, if you don't want to pay for the stallion service, don't bid!

Please keep in mind that you need to communicate with the stallion manager/stallion owner/breeding agent to make your breeding successful. Some stallions have a show schedule. Don't wait until the day you need semen, but plan ahead and keep them informed.

By submitting this form, the bidder agrees and acknowledges that he/she fully realizes and accepts that there is a possible danger of injury, sickness, or death involved in the breeding of horses and the attendant care of the mare. The bidder voluntarily assumes all risk of accident, injury, sickness or death to said mare and specifically releases the KWPN of North America, its directors, officers, employees and agents from all liability for any and all injury to, disability suffered by, or sickness or death of the mare or foal from any cause whatsoever, and specifically waives any and all claims resulting from such injury, disability, sickness or death.

The bidder specifically acknowledges and understands that The KWPN of North America makes no warranties either expressed or implied in connection with this agreement. It is expressly understood that the KWPN-NA is acting only as a clearinghouse in providing the Stallion Service Auction to breeders and that the stallion owner in turn has agreed to contribute the purchase price of the stallion service fee to benefit the activities of KWPN-NA. There are, specifically, no guarantees of conception or delivery of a live foal.
