Together with Little Creek Farm, the KWPN-NA is pleased to offer the Willy Arts Award. This Award is a financial grant intended to recognize and aid in the development of top performing KWPN-NA horse/rider combinations in a Young Rider division

Willy Arts Grant, sponsored by Little Creek Farm

Eligibility:

Rider - The applicant must be a current KWPN-NA member (any type), between the ages of 16 to 21, and be competing on a KWPN registered horse in a recognized Young Rider program.

Horse - The horse must be KWPN (Dutch) registered and have papers on file at the KWPN-NA office. If not owned by the competitor, the KWPN-NA office must have a lease on file.

Ownership - The current owner must be owner of record on the registration paper on file. If the competitor leases the horse, the owner does not need to be a current member.

Definition The Willy Arts Award is a financial grant intended to recognize and aid in the development of KWPN-NA horse/rider combinations competing in the Young Riders program.

Grant Amount: Three cash grants of \$2,000 will be awarded.

Use: Winners may use funds to cover lesson or clinic fees, competition fees for Young Rider Finals or for educational seminars or demonstrations

Selection Process: Any Young Rider meeting the eligibility requirements may submit an application for the grant to the KWPN-NA office on or before February 28th of each calendar year. Grant recipients will be chosen by Mr. Willy Arts. Selections will be announced after the KWPN-NA Annual Meeting in March of each year.

By signing this application the applicant agrees to:

- Submit an accounting and/or receipts for the amount of the Grant.
- Complete the follow-up/closing questionnaire.
- Write a summary of his or her experience for publication in the Newsletter.
- Send a high quality photo of Rider and Horse to go with above.
