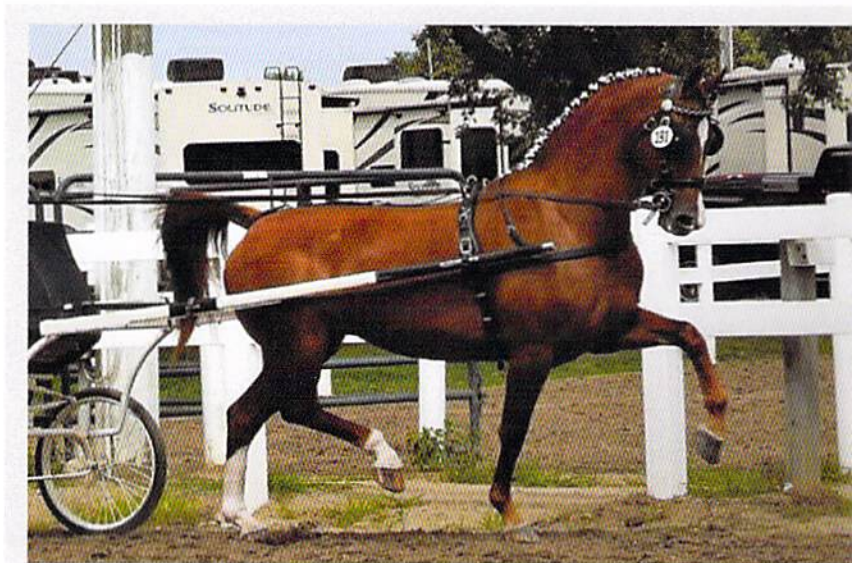
Our focus is to keep our community more updated on upcoming events and the event results. We look forward to promoting the Harness Horse in the future and hope you can help us!

County Fairgrounds Champion Mare

Owned by Douwe Plantinga, Charisma is a Keur mare by Vaandrager, out of Kind Lady by Fortissimo. Douwe bought the mare from David Beachy of Goshen, IN, as he was in search of a mare that would also be appropriate for combined driving. She has at this moment four offspring that received the ster predicate, thus giving her the preferent predicate. As a four year old, she was the national champion four year old in harness. Later coming to America, she was presented in the lbop, where she was the highest scoring lbop horse, receiving the high score of 80 points. In 2019 she competed in Fine harness where she became the champion mare, and now has 24 winning points!



She also competes in combined driving and was 1st place at the combined driving competition in Ames, Iowa. Douwe says she has a lovely character and is good looking and forward. A healthy mare that likes to work, she has never had any lameness issues. The plan is to compete in Fine harness to receive points for the sport predicate.

Oregon Trophy 2020

Harm-Jan Veenstra drove seven-year-old Icellie (Bocellie out of Petrose ster pref by Fabricus, breeder JR Bosch) to the victory in the prestigious Oregon Trophy. Of the five-person field in the competitive battle for harness horse stallions, Icellie managed to convince both the jury and the enthusiastic audience the most.

Delviro already won the Oregon Trophy in 2016 and was one of the favorites today. Ditsem, the champion of the stallion inspection in his vintage, also participated. Just like Dylano, who twice won the Manno Trophy. The youngest participant, Kane BF, made his debut this year in the Oregon Trophy.

2020 Stallion Show Results

For Macho van het Fledderbosch (Indiana from Emone ster v. Unieko breeder J. Arends from Garmerwolde, registered H. Dekker from Oosterwolde and K. Buist from Nuis) the champion ribbon was not a novelty. As a foal he was once the best at the National foal inspection and today he became the undisputed number one.

The enthusiastic public and the stallion selection committee were able to quickly agree on the best of the vintage: Macho van het Fledderbosch was given the championship ribbon for the second time in his life. He managed to convince on the move and that is why he came above Michellando van Altrido (Icellie from Heolanda D keur IBOP-harness v. Cizandro breeder A. Doornbos and T. Doornbos-Bos from Beilen, registered L. Wijkmans from Elshout) and Mooiman (Dylano from Zarona elite pref IBOP-harness PROK by Manno breeder A. Epskamp from Hoevelaken, registered Van Manen brothers from Ede). A total of nine stallions were invited for the performance test. Macho was recently sold to Erin Shea and Bill Duffy of Ashby, MA and will be imported after his stallion performance test.
