Our Presenters

Families Van Straaten

Performance breeders with 1 goal -- Breeding Show Jumping Horses for Top Level Sport

The Van Straaten family from Den Ham is a household name in the horse world. The family has bred more than 20 showjumpers that have jumped at 1.60m and the rest jumped at 1.35m, 1.40m and 1.45m. Together with their children, Fred and Frieda have been running the “De Hazelhorst” for decades, a riding school where many children have learned to ride.

World-class horses such as Fellini-S, Dittorio-S, Andretti-S, Eldorado-S, Arc de Triomphe, Wladimir S, Typhoon S, Loyd and Handel are just a small selection from the family's successful

breeding. These successes are only possible through strict selection, in which the Van Straaten's always keep the credo "from sport comes sport" in mind.

The Van Straaten family is involved in multiple facets of equestrian sports, which visibly reinforce each other. In addition to the well-known show jumping breeding, trade and training are also important element of this family business.



Sabine Schut-Kery

Sabine Schut-Kery is an elite dressage rider and trainer who competes internationally and delights audiences with extraordinary equestrian exhibitions.



Sabine is originally from Krefeld, Germany, where she was classically trained under Jean Bemelmans for three years before completing her official “Bereiter” exam with the Federation

Nationale in Germany. She continued to study with Jan Nivelle and Stefanie Meyer-Biss. Recognized for her talent at a young age, she trained two Friesian stallions, Tinus PM and Jorrit PM, through Grand Prix. Both horses were awarded the Golden Horse Award by the German FPZV for outstanding accomplishments in the sport of dressage. Early in her career, her portfolio of diverse horsemanship was evident as Sabine earned her silver medal in driving, which requires driving a four-in-hand.

In 1998, Sabine came to the United States to be the head trainer at Proud Meadows in Texas. While there, Sabine competed in dressage with young horses through Grand Prix and participated in exhibition riding. Sabine choreographed and rode numerous quadrilles, pas de deux at Grand Prix level, sidesaddle and ride and drive performances. In 2005, Sabine moved to California where she continues to train and compete horses of all levels in dressage. She also continues to participate in exhibitions.

Sabine has won numerous international competitions with young horses as well as FEI horses. In 2015, she competed for the United States of America at the Pan American Games in Toronto and came home with a Team Gold Medal in Dressage. She was recently awarded the Carol Lavelle Advanced Dressage Training Grant and spent the fall of 2017 in Europe doing focused training and competition with her Grand Prix partner, Sanceo. In 2018, she earned a spot representing the US at the Nations Cup, where Team USA won the team gold, and swept the podium in the Grand Prix Freestyle. Sabine continues to advance her own education under the brilliant eye of Olympian Christine Traurig.

Sabine operates her boutique dressage training business out of San Marcos, California. She trains and competes with Dutch stallions Gorgeous Latino and Sonnenberg’s Jersey.

In 2021, Sabine rode Alice Womble's Sanceo in the Tokyo Olympics, winning a team silver medal.

Van Olst Horses

Stallions at stud, youngstock, sport, purchase & sale

Van Olst Horses is a professional equestrian business that operates internationally within all facets of the modern jumping / dressage sport and breeding. Stallions at stud, youngstock, sport, purchase and sale, complement each other seamlessly through a system developed over the years based on own experience and own philosophy. The aim is: "To strive for the highest possible quality in everything".

Van Olst Horses has been active in the International equestrian business since 1983. With approved Showjumping stallions such as Animo and Zalmeco the business quickly made a furore. Gertjan's wife Anne Van Olst, a Danish-born rider, participated five times in the Olympic Games for the Danish team. Under the influence of Anne, the focus of the organization changed more towards the dressage sport and breeding. Gertjan and Anne have proven to be a true power couple in the sport of dressage. Their dressage breeding and sports success together started with the stallion Negro (Ferro x Variant). With Negro and later Lord Leatherdale, Van Olst horses has built up a stable full of approved stallions and top sport horses. Performance in sport is key for Van Olst: each of their approved stallions are sporthorses also, on the way to or competing at the Grand Prix.

We highlight two of their most successful Lord Leatherdale x Negro KWPN approved stallions: Everdale and Glamourdale. Everdale keur is number 4 on the FEI World ranking dressage,

winner of Olympic bronze and European silver and has already sired an incredible number of top dressage offspring.

Glamourdale, recently also declared keur, was FEI World Champion for 7-year-old dressage horses in 2018, Winner of the CHIO Aachen 2019, 3x KWPN Horse of the Year, 2x World Champion Herning 2022, 2x Bronze Olympic Games Paris in 2024. At Jumping Amsterdam beginning 2025, they won the Champions title again.

Van Baalen Horses & Dressage

Decades of experience, craftsmanship and love for horses. In the 1970s, Arie Sr. and Coby van Baalen settled down in Brakel in the



province of Gelderland to further build up the family business 'Van Baalen'. This resulted in Baalen's worldwide renowned Olympic Dressage Barn and a successful

agricultural branch. Today, Arie Jr. van Baalen is at the helm of the agricultural branch, Van Baalen and Marlies van Baalen is responsible for the Dressuurstal Van Baalen.

Dressage is at its best when horse and rider work together in perfect harmony. That is what Marlies and Coby van Baalen strive for every day at Dressuurstal Van Baalen (DVB). Everything is focused on allowing horse and rider to develop their talents optimally with pleasure, with the well-being of horse and rider as

the basis. This is based on the conviction that dressage is a true team sport.

Because everything has to be right, Dressuurstal Van Baalen offers the complete package: the accommodation, the guidance during training and competitions, the physical and mental care for horse and rider and... the fun!

Coby Van Baalen

Coby rode many top dressage stallions, like Ulft, Zonneglans, Roemer and Winston, but became best known with the legendary black stallion Ferro. With him, she won team Silver at the Olympic Games in Sydney (2000). In total, Coby won nine medals at the Dutch senior Championships and won Silver individually in the World Cup finals in Den Bosch (2000).

In addition, Coby is trainer-coach 6 of NOC*NSF, Knight in the Royal 'Order of Orange Nassau', founder of the DVB Foundation and ambassador of Manege In 't Biobos in Arnhem (National Horse Riding Centre for the Disabled) and of the Prins Willem Alexander Manege (Association of Horse Riding for the Disabled in Amsterdam).

Marlies Van Baalen

Marlies is well known as rider of the American stallion Idocus Crown. She represented the Netherlands at the 2004 and 2020 Olympic Games, rode nine European Youth Championships and became Dutch Senior Champion in 2023. She competes nationally and internationally, currently with homebred Habibi DVB and Jackie Kennedy DVB and GoLegend is another competition horse she is very successful with.

Marlies also coaches several riders. "Working with people and animals is incredibly rewarding. Getting the most out of every

horse and myself is a challenge every day. I pass this on to my students when coaching.”

The newest part of the renowned family business is Van Baalen Farms – a super modern, five star facility for raising Young horses. The driving forces behind this top notch rearing stable in Brakel are Arie Jr. and his wife Jacobine van Baalen. Together, they manage the breeding stable where decades of expertise in the agricultural sector, equestrian sports and rearing form the basis for the well-being and health of young horses.



Dr. Carrie Finno

Dr. Carrie Finno from UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine Population Health & Reproduction will be our speaker on the genetic research program that runs at UC Davis on C6 and C7 neck problems and kissing spine in sport horses. Dr. Carrie Finno, DVM, PHD, Dipl. ACVIM Director and Professor and Agronomist, has a specialty focus on equine internal medicine. Her laboratory investigates the genetic basis of neurodegenerative diseases using animal models.

Current relevant research programs that Dr. Finno is running as Principal Investigator:

- Validation of Biomarkers for Equine Neurodegeneration
- Long-range sequencing for equine neuroaxonal dystrophy (eNAD)
- Unraveling the Genetic Etiology of Equine Neuroaxonal Dystrophy in Quarter Horses and Warmbloods
